### **Information to be given to the emergency services operator**

- The nearest access to the towpath is from Little Tring Road (see over for precise location) or the canal bridge in The Holloway, Drayton Beachamp (see over for precise locations)
- Access to the casualty is restricted by the width of the towpath which is generally of 2m usable width.
- There is a 2m+ wide concrete “road” on the bed of the canal for most of the way.
- The casualty is about ???m (put approximate distance here) from the access gate along the towpath. The distance from the gate in Little Tring Road to Bridge 4 is 640m and the distance to Whitehouses is 820m. From Drayton Beauchamp bridge to Whitehouses, the distance is 1080m. If possible use a What3Words location.  
The casualty is on the bed of the canal (if he or she is) and will need to be lifted up to the towpath.
- The canal bank slopes at 45° i.e. it is not (usually) possible to use a vertical lift.
- The ground level drops on both sides of the towpath by about 3m and the width of the canal is limited i.e. access by air ambulance is difficult.
